Dear Applicant,

Thank you for your interest in joining the Royal Order of Kamehameha I. The following will give you a capsule view of this organization.

### **HISTORY**

King Kamehameha V created the Order in 1865 to honor the memory of his grandfather, Kamehameha I. During the turbulent period of the overthrow of the monarchy, the Order went underground and was dormant until Prince Kūhio re-activated the Order in 1902. Its purpose is to preserve and perpetuate Hawaiian culture, to care for widows and orphans, and to attend to the welfare of its members.

Throughout its rich history, the Order has stood as a symbol of the chiefs of Hawaii nei. Some of the most prominent citizens of the Hawaiian Kingdom, the Territory and the State of Hawaii have been counted among its members.

### **QUALIFICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP**

- Must be of Hawaiian ancestry.
- A male at least 18 years of age.
- Be of good moral character.
- Sponsored by a member of the Order.

### **APPLICATION FORM**

Candidates are required to submit a completed application form with a \$25 initiation fee payable to *Pōhai 'O Kamehameha*. The fee is payable by check or money order. Do not send cash. If you do not complete the initiation process, the fee will be returned to you. The initiation fee will cover the cost of the following items which will be presented upon successful completion of the three-step initiation process:

- Hawai'i Chapter Tie Pin
- By-Laws
- Mourning Ribbon to be worn in commemoration of a recently-deceased member.

### **MONTHLY MEETINGS**

The Order meets on the first Thursday of the month at 6:00 PM at the Kana'ina Building, which is located on the grounds of the 'Iolani Palace. This is a regular meeting called Aha Kapu and is open only to members of the Royal Order.

The third Thursday of each month is the Officers Business Meeting of the Chapter and is called the 'Aha Kūkā. It takes place at 6:00 PM in the Hale Laulima Building Conference Room on the Kamehameha Schools Kapālama campus or virtually by Zoom. Although it is the Officers Business Meeting, it is open to all members.

During months with five Thursdays, the fifth Thursday of the month features an informal gathering (Hui Pū) at Kana'ina on the grounds of 'Iolani Palace with guest presenters on culture, arts or other matters of interest. This presentation concludes with a potluck.

### **INITIATION**

Initiation occurs through a three-step process during successive three months in which you will progress through the first three degrees: Malihini, Hoa Hele, and Mamo Hawai'i.



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### **First Degree: *Malihini***

Candidates for the First Degree are initiated at a regular meeting of the Chapter. The time and place of the meeting will be provided to you by your sponsor.

You must appear for this degree and the *Hoahale* degree dressed in:

- White long-sleeve dress shirt
- Black necktie
- Black dress slacks and black belt
- Black dress socks/shoes.

### **Second Degree: *Hoahale***

A month following your initiation into the First Degree, you will be received into the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree of Hoahale. Attire is the same as for *Malihini*. At this time you are expected to make your advance payment of \$85 to pay for your 'Ahu (cape) that you will receive at the next step.

### **Third Degree: *Mamo Hawai'i***

The third month is the final step to becoming a full member of the Royal Order of Kamehameha I. You will receive the 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree of Mamo Hawai'i and be clothed with the 'Ahu'ula or Red Cape of your rank. You will be presented with the Order's pin which is worn on your necktie, by-laws, and mourning ribbon. The cost is included in the initiation fee that you paid upon submitting your application. The attire is full regalia which is outlined below. At this time, you are to pay your annual dues if not paid earlier.

## **ANNUAL DUES AND ASSESSMENTS**

Upon completion of your 3<sup>rd</sup> degree as a Mamo Hawai'i, you are expected to pay for your membership dues for the current year. Membership dues and assessments are paid on an annual calendar year basis. The amount shown is the current fee and may change in future years. The annual dues as of January 2019 are as follows:

- Mamo Hawai'i Chapter Dues and Assessments \$115.00

## **HOW TO PAY**

Check or money order payable to Pōhai 'O Kamehameha as outlined above. Alternatively, you may pay with credit card via PayPal on the kamehameha.org website under the Donate tab. Please add a \$5.00 service fee for each PayPal transaction. Cash is accepted in-person only for the exact amount; do not mail cash.

## **FULL REGALIA**

Whenever the Order attends formal functions, members are attired in full regalia consisting of:

- Black suit
- White long sleeve shirt
- Black necktie with Order's pin
- Black shoes with black socks
- Ahu (cape)
- Mourning ribbon when appropriate and as directed.

## **YOUR SPONSOR**

Your sponsor is your mentor and is the one to whom you should address your questions about the Order or the initiation process.

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## APPLICATION FEE

The application fee is \$25. The fee covers the cost of one (1) Order emblem pin, one (1) copy of By-Laws and one (1) ribbon worn during mourning periods for deceased members. These items will be given to candidate upon completion of the third and final initiation step to become Third Degree Mamo Hawai‘i. Once the applicant attains the rank of Mamo Hawai‘i, the initiation fee is non-refundable. If the application is rejected, the applicant’s fee will be refunded.
